





CONTRIBUTORS TO PAARA'S HOMEBREW SHOW-AND-TELL May 7, 1993

- AA6PA BIII Rausch, two compact 2M quads good for RDF (Radio Direction Finding)
- W6EMD Dave Meecham, a 750W 2M amplifier using an EIMAC conductively cooled tube, as in a recent QST front cover article
- WA6LNV Gerry Tucker, an Incompleted DSP (Digital Signal Processor) box for taking out tuner-uppers on HF, etc., as in a late 1992 QST article
- KB6HDC Joe Gomes, a battery replacement clip for an HT, allowing use of a larger belt-hung battery or other higher power sources
- W6NBI Bob Stein, a noise generator for receiver design/test, as in his HAM RADIO article around 1979
- KM6EP Dick Kors, an SSTV (slow scan TV) unit, as in Jan 1993 QST
- K6TYO Bill Fles, a foldup J-pole on a stand, a tiny homebrew SWR bridge, and he also brought his working Doppler RDF control box
- N6ZFX Jeff Crilly, a code practice oscillator and attached Morse key, which he used to learn code for getting his ticket
- VE3FZK Andy Korsak, a switched-dipole RDF antenna which you hold in front of an HT, looking for a null in a tone when you face the signal source
