





#### BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING.

**September 15, 2004** 

The regular monthly meeting of the PAARA Board of Directors was held on Wednesday, September 15/04 at the

Red Cross offices in Palo Alto. The meeting was called to order by President Andreas Junge, N6NU at 1930 hours local time. In attendance was Vice President Jim Rice, K6AK; Treasurer Ron Chester, W6AZ; Secretary Terry Finn, AF6TF; PAARAgraphs editor Wally Porter, K6URO; Board members Gerry Tucker, N6NV; Bob Korte, KD6KYT; Adrianus Schrauwen, W6AJS; Rolf Klibo, N6NFI and Vic Black, AB6SO. PAARA members Dave Rogers, K5DKR; Steve Brune, KG6OUB; Stan Towle, WA6ZGI and Peter Sheerin, K6WEB also attended.

Treasurer **Ron Chester** presented a rather detailed report on the costs of various events sponsored by PAARA so far in 2004. He provided an insight into how PAARA may have to restrict spending on future events and consider raising the membership fee so that costs can be covered. This whole debate was tabled until the results are in and tabulated by the committee that is preparing and running the membership survey.

**Peter Sheerin** provided an up-date regarding specific changes that he has made to the PAARAsite web page. To facilitate ease of use for PAARA members who may wish to use the special interest group portions of the PAARAsite, he will make several changes to the wiki page format.

A new committee was established to review the Association By-Laws which have not been up-dated for many years. Serving on the committee, as appointed by the President are: Adrianus Schrauwen; Ron Chester and Peter Sheerin. It will be known as the PAARA By-Law Review

Committee and will report directly to the Board of Directors on a monthly basis. Any amendments will be presented to the general membership at a regular meeting to be voted upon before the new by-laws will take effect.

As many new members are joining PAARA, it has been suggested that ARRL members should bring their older, out-dated or un-used copies of QST to a regular Friday evening meeting so they can be given to the new PAARA members or guests. This will assist newer hams in discovering the value, benefits and existence of the national radio organization. We are still attempting to obtain a 51 per cent member of ARRL ratio so we can once again become an officially recognized ARRL radio club.

Starting in January 2005, Gerry Tucker will be bringing his truck to the Friday evening PAARA meeting that occurs closest to the Saturday morning electronic flea market. This will allow PAARA members and guests to donate various items of radio or electronic interest to PAARA. Gerry will then establish a sales booth at the flea market to sell the donated items. All proceeds will go directly to the PAARA general operating fund.

Jim Rice continues to provide excellent meeting speakers and raffle prize entertainment. If a PAARA member has an idea regarding a speaker, please do not hesitate to contact Jim directly and personally as it is a rather tough job. The raffle prize event is still viable and creating lots of excitement at the meetings.

The PAARA sponsored code training class will start on Tuesday evening, Sept 28/04 in Redwood City at the Sequoia Club, 1695 Broadway at 7 pm. It will run every Tuesday and Thursday evening for eight weeks.






